## Checking In and Music

**Solos** and **duos** must sign in at the **eisteddfod registration desk** at the time indicated on the schedule above. If you are late, you may be withdrawn from the section. Students must also bring back up music on a USB or CD in case the music does not work. KDA has already provided the Eistedford with the music.

**Troupes**, please meet in the foyer and a KDA teacher will come and find you. KDA will check in for you and bring back up music.

## Backstage

For **solos** and **duos**, if a KDA teacher is not available, one parent (or helper) is allowed to go backstage with the dancer/s to help them get ready. They must have a WWCC if over 18 and not a performer.

For **troupes**, parents will not be allowed backstage. KDA will collect the students from the foyer and meet parents back in the foyer after the students have performed.

## Costumes

Students must wear their body stockings and tights to the theatre with dance clothes over the top. Hair should already be done in the hairstyle discussed with teachers. All students must bring their costumes to the Theatre with them (exception: Monday Senior Troupe, KDA will bring them). Students can get changed into their costumes once checked in and backstage. All students taking their own costumes must return them to KDA the first week of term 3.
